No. SO(J-I)/HD/8-1(04)/2020-Corona. In pursuance of the Government of Sindh Notification bearing No. SO(CTC)/SGA&CD/COVID-19/Committee/2020 dated 24.03.2020 and 08.04.2020, and Committee constituted vide Home Department, Government of Sindh Notification bearing No. SO(Jud-I)HD/8-1(04)/2020-Corona dated 28th April, 2020, the committee-I examined the requests / applications received from the export-oriented industries in the light of Home Department Order No. SO(Jud-I)HD/8-1(04)/2020-Corona dated 14th April 2020, wherein such industries were allowed to operate subject to the condition of ensuring adherence to SOPs bearing No. SO(Jud-I)HD/8-1(04)/2020-Corona/SOPs dated 14th April 2020, issued by Home Department in view of COVID-19 measures.

2. Now, therefore, on the recommendations received from the Secretary, Industries & Commerce Department / Chairman, Committee-I vide letter No. I&CD/F.P/HOME-001/2020 dated 2nd May 2020, the following export-oriented factories / manufacturing units, which are found fulfilling the criteria as per the Order and SOPs referred above {i.e. (i) Verification of export order by TDAP, (ii) Undertaking by CEO/owner on ensuring arrangements within their premises as per SOPs referred above for COVID - 19 prevention, and (iii) List of workers/staff/management who will be present/working in the premises of factory/manufacturing unit during its operation}. These units are permitted to start their operation (for export related items) subject to adherence to the SOPs.

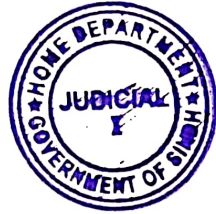

The required details are name, father's name, designation, CNIC Number, residential address, cell number (if any).
