EOBI notices demanding arrears of contribution & Update on Appeal in the Supreme Court

It has come to our notice that EOBI is issuing notices to companies demanding arrears of EOBI contribution.

In this context, we would like to inform our members that since the Appeal has been filed in the Supreme Court of Pakistan against the Judgement of the Sindh High Court, such notices are subjudice and should be responded to accordingly.

We request our members that in case they receive such notices from EOBI, they may be forwarded to EFP in which case an appropriate reply will be drafted and shared for onward communication to EOBI.

We would like to further emphasize that such a response can only be given by companies that are parties to the appeal filed in the Supreme Court.

As an update for companies that have already approached EFP to be petitioners in the appeal, we would like to inform you that the Appeals have been filed in the Supreme Court of Pakistan against the Judgement of the Sindh High Court and as soon as numbers are allotted, respective petitioner companies will be informed.

Companies that were a party to the petition in the Sindh High Court and have not yet filed their Appeal in the Supreme Court, are advised to immediately approach the EFP Secretariat with necessary documents so that they may be made parties to the Appeal in the Supreme Court.

Even those companies which were not a party to the Sindh High Court case but want to be a party in the Appeal in Supreme Court, are also advised to immediately approach EFP along with required documents so that they may be made parties to the Appeal in the Supreme Court.

EFP is available for every possible assistance in the matter.
