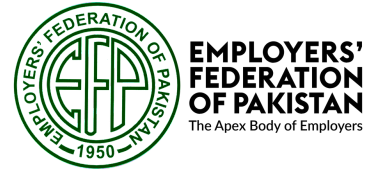


17th Occupational Safety, Health, & Environment Award 2022^(FY)

- **Health Care & Pharmaceutical Sector** – Drugs & medicines manufacturers, Pharmaceutical companies, hospitals, & health care facilities.
- **Service Sector** – Banks, Hotels, Restaurants, Hospitality & Catering, Hospitals, Educational & Research Institutes, Construction, Human Resources Consultancy, Telecommunications, IT, Media, Financial Institutions, Insurance companies, Wholesale and Retail services, Distribution & Storage.
- **Transport & Logistics** - Transport (Air, Sea & Land), Port handling, trucking, haulage, bulk cargo terminals, etc,
- **Textiles, Leather & Sports** - Ginning, Blending, Processing, Garments, Tanning, finished products, Sports goods, sports kits, accessories, and all other sub-sectors having independent Trade Bodies.
- **Engineering, Automobile manufacturing, and Spare Parts / Components** - HMV, LMV, Tractors, Motorcycles, Spare Parts Production, engineering equipment and machinery manufacturing, foundries, electrical & electronic products manufacturing, paper & packaging.
- **Other** - Not covered by any of the above categories.

The participating organizations will be evaluated on the basis of a self-declaration response to the standardized questionnaire which will be verified by an Evaluation Committee of highly competent and expert OSHE professionals.

Supporting Documents	Please attempt all questions and provide supporting information as evidence to enable the assessors to make a sound judgment and a fair evaluation
On-site Verification	Contestants may also receive a follow-up call or an on-site verification visit with prior notification
